BE PREPARED FEE DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION: For Scouts who are signed up for Northwoods and have their fee paid IN FULL by May 15, 2009 there will be a special “ Early Bird” incentive discount of \$10.00 per Scout (\$240 if Dining hall, \$185 if patrol cooking) if a Payment of \$75.00 per Scout is received in The Council Service Center postmarked or receipted on or before **March 31st**, and the Balance is received by **May 15th**.

\$20.00 per additional Scout discount if the deposit is received in the Council Service Center postmarked or receipted on or before **March 31st** and the balance is of a received by **May 15th**.

NEW SCOUT: New Boy Scouts registered with a troop after **May 15th and before June 1st** are eligible for the discount (\$240), after June 1st, the fee is \$250.

These dates are firm.

MULTIPLE WEEK STAY: Scouts staying Multiple weeks receive a \$20 discount for additional weeks.

MULTIPLE SCOUT FAMILY: Families with More than one registered Boy Scout pay the full fee for the first Scout and will receive a

REFUND POLICY

Because most of the camp fees are actually spent prior to your arrival at camp for food, salaries, and program supplies, refunds for campers will be made only under all the following conditions:

- A. All requests for refunds must be in writing and no later than 10 days after the Troop's departure from camp.
- B. Refunds will only be given for extenuating circumstances (illness, death in the immediate family or jury duty), but will not be given for no-shows or campers leaving camp early.
- C. There will be NO refund issued for a request received after August 8, 2009.
- D. A \$45.00 (administrative fee) per Scout or paid Leader will be assessed for any refund.
- E. Fees may be transferred from one person to another within the same unit without any additional fees due.
- F. All refund requests must be accompanied with written documentation: a doctor's note a copy of an obituary or a copy of jury duty summons.

If in doubt, it is better to pay later than request a refund.
