WHERE IS NORTHWOODS SCOUT RESERVATION?

Northwoods is located near West Branch, MI
From the intersection of Tawas Road (M55) and F9 in West Branch, proceed East on Tawas Road (M55) 12 miles to Henderson Road. Turn left (North) onto Henderson Road and go 4 miles to Peters Road. Turn right (East) on Peters Road and proceed about 1 mile to the camp.

Northwoods Scout Reservation is blessed with 640 acres of wooded and rolling terrain including 100-acre Arrowhead Lake for your enjoyment. We will provide all food, program equipment, activities, and a tent with cots and mattresses. Campers need only bring personal gear. Don't forget your fishing rods. Our lake is full of fish!

Parent & Son Camp is a two+ day, two night camping experience for Cub Scouts and adult partners. Adults must be at least 18 years of age.

SIGN UP EARLY!

The number of campers who can be accommodated limits registrations to the first 135 pairs! This camp often fills up quickly so don't delay!
